

Immigration of skilled workers under the accelerated procedure

The new Skilled Workers Immigration Act will come into force in Germany on 01.03.2020. According to this, companies can apply for the entry of skilled workers or trainees to be carried out in an accelerated procedure.

Basic information

Under the new Skilled Workers Immigration Act, companies can allow trained employees and trainees to enter Germany in a so-called accelerated procedure, see § 81a Residence Act.

The prerequisite is that the employees have completed vocational training that is recognized or can be recognized in Germany, see also: <https://fachkraefteeinwanderungsgesetz.de/>.

An application for entry of such a skilled worker or trainee can be submitted by companies based in Bremen to the Migration Office.

Persons who do not live in Germany and would like to come to Germany as employees, trainees and students, please continue to contact the German embassy in their home country and apply for a visa there, s.b. our service description: "Residence permit for employment".

Procedure

If you would like to hire a foreign skilled worker or a foreign trainee who is still living abroad and your company is based in Bremen, you can apply to the Migration Office for the professional recognition and visa procedure to be carried out in an accelerated procedure.

You will receive an answer within a week or an immediate appointment at the Migration Office, so that we can clarify the requirements in a personal consultation and start the procedure if the requirements are met.
