

Purchase of a Euro-key for disabled toilets

Basic information

The Euro key was introduced back in 1986 by the Club Behinderter und ihre Freunde in Darmstadt und Umgebung e. V. (Club of Disabled People and their Friends in Darmstadt and the surrounding area). With its introduction, the club aimed to provide physically disabled people with a standardized key that would give them free access to disabled toilets.

The facilities include highway and train station toilets as well as public toilets, among others.

In 2017, there were around 12,000 disabled toilets in Europe.

Requirements

Presentation of a severely disabled person's ID card with one of the following symbols:

- aG sign
- sign B
- sign H
- Sign Bl
- Sign G and a degree of disability of 70

Please note that the Euro key can only be issued to citizens of Bremen. Interested persons from the surrounding area of Bremen please go directly via CBF Darmstadt.

What documents do I need?

- Severely disabled pass
- in case of representation with written power of attorney
 - Additionally: identity card or passport of the authorized person

Procedure

You can obtain the Euro key directly from the office of the State Disability Officer (visiting address: Marktstraße 3 / Börsenhof C, 28195 Bremen) on presentation of your disabled person's ID card.

In order to avoid duplication, we kindly ask you to contact us in advance, as we only have a certain number of keys in stock.

If you are unable to collect it in person, a person you trust can collect it from us with a power of attorney issued by you.
