

Apply for hardship waiver of BAföG repayment debt after rejection of a cooperation waiver

If Cooperation Forgiveness has been denied, you may apply for hardship forgiveness of your loan under certain circumstances.

Competent Department

• Bundesverwaltungsamt (BVA), BF I - Ausbildungsdarlehen

Basic information

Your decision for or against a BAföG education loan should not lead you to fears of debt. Thus, you can apply for a hardship waiver if the cooperation waiver was rejected.

Hardship means only a minor violation of your obligations to pay and cooperate throughout the repayment period.

Your request may

- lead to a hardship waiver:
 - You will have the (remaining) debt of your BAföG loan forgiven.
- lead to a rejection:
 - You must repay the remaining debt in the amount of your BAföG loan, including outstanding costs and interest.

You can submit your application informally

- by telephone,
- · in writing and
- online

at the Federal Office of Administration (BVA).

Requirements

You can submit an application if

 you have been refused a cooperation waiver by the Federal Office of Administration (BVA).

Requirements for the hardship waiver:

- within the repayment period
 - address tracing costs have been levied against you no more than once
 - This happens if you have not notified the Federal Office of Administration (BVA) of a change of name or address and the BVA has had to investigate this.
 - you have never been definitively fined
 - fines are levied if you have not reported changes to the relevant family and income circumstances during an exemption or deferral
 - you have settled all payment obligations, including claims for costs and interest
 - interest on arrears has accrued for a maximum period of 150 days.

Note

Interest is always charged if you are more than 45 days in arrears with a payment.

Procedure

You can send the request informally

- by telephone
- · in writing and
- online

at the Federal Office of Administration (BVA).

- If you submit your application by telephone:
 - Call one of the BVA phone numbers provided.
 - Make the request.
- If you make your application in writing:
 - Send the informal, as well as signed application stating your reference number by mail to the BVA.
- If you submit your application online:
 - Open the BAföG online portal of the BVA and register there.
 - After registration, you will receive a confirmation by e-mail. Follow the steps in the email to complete the registration.
 - Log in to the BAföG-Online portal.
 - Click on "Application Forms" and select the "Hardship Waiver" form by clicking on the "Submit Application" button.
 - Fill out the form and press the button "Send".
- You will receive the decision on your application by mail from the BVA.
- If your application is approved, you will be debt-free and will not have to repay the loan.
- If your application is denied, you will have to repay the remaining loan debt, including any outstanding costs and interest, in one lump sum.

What deadlines must be paid attention to?

Within 1 month after the rejection of the cooperation decree.
