

# Application for admission to a technical school in Bremen

Training at a technical school is an advanced training program that prepares students to take on tasks at the middle management level in companies. You can find out how to apply for admission to a technical school in the municipality of Bremen here.

## Basic information

Training at a technical college is an advanced training program that prepares you to take on tasks at the middle management level in companies. Completion of vocational school training entitles you to enter a course of study at a university.

The following degrees can be obtained at a specialized school:

- State-certified educator at a vocational school for social pedagogy
- State-certified business economist (Betriebswirtin / Staatlich geprüfter Betriebswirtin), specializing in personal services at a technical school for personal services
- State-certified nurse for curative education at a specialized school for curative education
- State-certified technician at a technical school for technology

The training usually takes place in full-time form. Some technical schools also offer part-time training.

The training period is two years in full-time form and is correspondingly longer in part-time form.

## Requirements

The prerequisite for attending a technical college is a completed vocational training and the intermediate school leaving certificate.

## What documents do I need?

- Completed admission form of the respective vocational school  
usually available via the school's homepage
- Evidence in accordance with the applicable admission requirements

## Procedure

- Select the desired technical school.
- Download the admission form from the homepage of the desired technical school or pick it up on site at the school secretary's office in paper form.
- Fill out the admission form and submit the completed admission form to the technical school along with the necessary documents according to the school's requirements.
- Once you have been selected by the technical school, you will receive a notification from the technical school regarding your acceptance or rejection.
