

Apply for recognition as a teacher with professional qualification from EU/EEA/ Switzerland

You have a professional qualification as a teacher from abroad and want to work in Germany? Then you need to have your professional qualification recognized.

Basic information

The State Examination Office is responsible for teaching examinations. It is responsible for determining the professional qualifications of foreign teachers for the acquisition of teaching and teaching qualification and for carrying out the relevant recognition procedures.

The determination of the equivalence of a teaching profession qualification acquired abroad with a teaching profession qualification in Bremen forms the basis for the recognition of foreign teaching profession qualifications. The prerequisite for equivalence is that there are no significant differences between the training abroad and the training for the intended teaching profession in Bremen according to the legal provisions. If significant differences or deviations are found in this respect, these can be compensated for by respective training and qualification measures. The decision on equivalence is made by the State Examination Office.

Requirements

- A completed foreign teacher training program (final product) with academic components.
- · You want to work as a teacher in Bremen.

You must meet further requirements for employment in the teaching profession:

- You have German language skills at the required level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). The responsible office will inform you about the required language level.
- Personal suitability: you are reliable for work as a teacher and have no criminal record.

· Health suitability: You are in good health.

Procedure

You submit an application to the responsible office. You can send the application by post, send it electronically or submit it in person. The responsible office will inform you.

The responsible office receives the application. It will confirm to you after a maximum of one month that the application has been received. Once the competent office has received all the documents from you, it will process your application. The competent authority will then check: Is your professional qualification equivalent to the professional qualification in your federal state? The competent body will compare the qualifications using certain criteria. Important criteria are, for example, the duration of the training, the content of the training and the number of subjects taught. The competent body will also take your professional experience, your other certificates of competence and your other qualifications into account when assessing equivalence.

If your professional qualification and the professional qualification in the selected federal state are equivalent, you will receive recognition.

Sometimes there are significant differences between the professional qualifications. If there are significant differences, you can usually take a compensatory measure.

There are various compensation measures:

- Adaptation course: you work as a teacher and perhaps do additional training. This
 means, for example, that you take part in courses at a university.
- Aptitude test: You take teaching tests and oral examinations. A teaching sample
 means that you conduct lessons with pupils. Examiners observe and assess your
 lessons. The responsible office will inform you about the necessary teaching samples
 and examinations.

You can usually choose between an adaptation period or an aptitude test. Sometimes the competent body decides which compensatory measure you should take. The responsible office will inform you.

If you successfully complete the compensation measure, you will receive recognition.

With this recognition, you can apply for the teaching profession in your federal state. apply. This is a separate procedure. The other requirements for the so-called teaching qualification are then checked.

If you meet all the requirements, you will be awarded the teaching qualification. The teaching qualification is always valid for the teaching position you have applied for. This

means that you can teach your subjects at a specific school. You have the same professional rights as a person with a German professional qualification.

There are various options depending on the federal state, to work as a teacher without recognition, e.g. via a lateral entry or at a private school. The responsible office will inform you about the details.

Opportunities for working as a teacher without recognition

There are various options for working as a teacher without recognition. Exactly which options you have depends on which federal state you would like to work in. The responsible office will inform you.

Options for working as a teacher without recognition include

- lateral entry
- lateral entry
- Direct entry
- Working as a substitute teacher
- Working at a private school
- · Working at international schools
- Teaching in the language of origin (mother tongue)
- Working in preparatory classes and support classes (e.g. German as a foreign language - DaF or German as a second language - DaZ)
- Working outside of a school (e.g. in adult education)

Partial professional access for professional qualifications from the EU, EEA or Switzerland: Your professional qualification is not equivalent and there are many significant differences? In some federal states, you may be able to work in the profession with partial access to the profession. With partial access to the profession, you can also work in the profession without recognition. There are certain requirements for this. As a teacher, you are then only allowed to take on certain tasks. You apply for partial access to the profession at the competent authority. The competent authority will inform you.

Equivalence with the 1st state examination

In most federal states, you can also have your professional qualification compared only with the German teaching degree (1st state examination). If your professional qualification is equivalent to the 1st state examination, then you can be admitted to the preparatory service or a lateral entry course, for example. The responsible office will inform you.

The preparatory service is the pedagogical-practical training. This training concludes with the 2nd state examination. The practical training is also called: Referendariat.

If you successfully complete the preparatory service, you can apply to teach at state schools. You have the same professional rights as a person with a German professional qualification.
