

Register collection of bulky waste

Do you have furnishings (furniture etc.) that you want to dispose of? Then you can order a bulky waste collection.

Basic information

Once a year, every private household can have bulky waste up to 5 m³ collected free of charge. However, bulky waste must be ordered separately for each household.

Bulky waste is furniture and furnishings from private households which, even after reasonable shredding, do not fit into the approved waste containers due to their bulkiness, weight or material properties, or which could damage them or make them difficult to empty.

Please remember to place your bulky waste on the sidewalk no earlier than 6 p.m. the day before or no later than 6 a.m. on the day of collection. If there is no sidewalk in front of the property and you need to place your bulky waste elsewhere, please contact the customer service department of Die Bremer Stadtreinigung in person.

This is bulky waste:

- Furniture and furnishings: sofa, lounger, bed, wardrobe, chest of drawers, table, mattress, slatted frame, armchair, chair, stool, shelf, suitcase (empty), carpet (rolled up or bundled), garden benches
- Large electrical appliances, metal objects, bed frames, spring frames, bicycles, baby carriages, scooters, lawnmowers, clothes horse
- Large plastic parts: Laundry basket, bathtub, garden furniture, Bobbycar®, rain barrel, sandpit shell, plastic sledge

This is not bulky waste:

- Residual waste and plastic parts: Items that fit into the Bremen bin liner in terms of size
- Construction waste: Windows, doors, laminate and sanitary ceramics, pipes, skirting boards and ceiling moldings
- Recyclables: paper and cardboard, garden waste, textiles, glass and yellow bags
- Pollutants: pollutants and waste containing asbestos
- Car parts: Car wrecks and car parts, motorcycles and tires

Requirements

The bulky waste comes from a private household that is connected to the municipal waste disposal system in Bremen.

What documents do I need?

- Object address
- Name

Procedure

Bulky waste collection can be ordered online or by telephone:

Online

• You can register your bulky waste using the order form. The online service will guide you through the process step by step.

By telephone

- You can register your bulky waste by telephone.
- You will receive an order confirmation by post or email once the order has been received with the collection date and important information about the process.
- The bulky waste must be provided in good time. From 18:00 the day before and at the latest by 06:00 on the day of collection.
- The maximum quantity per order is 5 cubic meters and the items should not exceed a length of 2 meters.

More information

If you would like to use the collection service together with your neighbor, each party must place a separate order.

Not everything that is no longer needed is waste. Second-hand department stores accept furniture that is still usable or you can offer it online yourself.

What deadlines must be paid attention to?

Only one free bulky waste collection per household is possible per year.

How long does it take to process

Collection takes place no later than 4 weeks after receipt of the application by the waste disposal company.

What are the costs?

Collection once per calendar year is already financed via the waste fee. 78,00 EUR for each additional removal.
