Basic information

The consistent application of compensation for disadvantages in examination-relevant services and final examinations requires a statement and recommendation from the Mobile Service or the Regional Counseling and Support Center, which must not be older than 18 months at the time of application. Medical or therapeutic statements

can be consulted in addition.

No reference may be made to any compensation for disadvantages granted in school reports and learning development reports.

Requirements

For pupils with physical and motor impairments, speech, hearing or visual impairments, autism spectrum disorder

- Timely application
- Current expert opinion from the Regional Counseling and Support Center or the Mobile Service with corresponding endorsement of compensation for disadvantages

What documents do I need?

- Informal application by the legal guardian or the adult student
- Current diagnostics of the Regional Counseling and Support Center or the Mobile Service

Procedure

- The informal application for an individual decision must be submitted to the school via the responsible school with the necessary documents for the diagnosis and previous consideration of the special reading and spelling difficulties.
- The school management decides on the compensation for disadvantages on the basis of a recommendation from the report conference, which is based on the knowledge and experience gained in the classroom as well as existing diagnoses, statements and expert opinions.
