Basic information

Poverty and Wealth Reports of the Senate of the Free Hanseatic City of Bremen are entitled "Living Conditions in the State of Bremen" and present an inventory of the social situation in the state of Bremen. The aim of the report is to present the poverty situation in the state of Bremen and to point out political options for action.

The first Poverty and Wealth Report was published in June 2009 after a public and professional discussion process. It covers the period 2000 - 2007. A data report was published in 2010 and 2011 to update the results of the study.

The second Poverty and Wealth Report is also already available. It mainly covers the period 2007 - 2012.

Procedure

The Senate of the Free Hanseatic City of Bremen took note of the draft of the second Poverty and Wealth Report on 13.01.2015. Now this draft will be discussed in various public and expert public events until June 2015 in order to gain further starting points for an improvement of the housing and living situation of people threatened and/or affected by poverty in Bremen.
