

Notify changes to the reliability requirements for professional supervision

Are you registered as a professional caregiver and have there been changes to your reliability requirements? Then you must inform your home authority immediately.

Basic information

Professional caregivers must prove their reliability when registering.

If there are any changes that mean that you are no longer reliable, you must inform the home authority immediately.

These can be

- The imposition of an occupational ban or a provisional occupational ban.
- A final conviction for a misdemeanor or felony.
- The initiation of preliminary or criminal proceedings.
- The initiation of insolvency proceedings.
- The loss of or a significant change in liability insurance cover.

Requirements

- · You are registered as a professional caregiver.
- There have been changes to your reliability requirements.

What documents do I need?

- Notification of changes to the reliability requirements
 - Can be done informally.

Procedure

If there are any changes to your reliability requirements, you must notify the home authority immediately.

- You can submit the notification in the following ways:
 - In writing by post
 - By e-mail

• Via the special electronic public authority mailbox (BebPo)
