Basic information

The notarization of signatures is for a specific purpose. In case of doubt, it will be checked whether a certification may be carried out in accordance with the relevant provisions.

Signatures may only be notarized for the purpose of submission to German offices or authorities.

What documents do I need?

- Identity card or passport
 - If a German identity card/passport is to be authenticated, a written proof of what this authentication is required for must be brought along.

Procedure

The signature must be made in person at the time of processing under the associated text.
