

Disposal of green waste

If you do not want to compost leaves, grass or shrub cuttings yourself, you can dispose of them as garden waste at the recycling stations.

Basic information

Garden waste up to a maximum of 1 m³ per delivery can be handed in at all recycling stations. Tree trunks and stumps over 10 cm are only accepted at the Blockland station. Garden waste over 1 m³ is subject to a fee and can only be disposed of at the Blockland recycling station.

The fees there are

- 20 € per additional cubic meter or part thereof for quantities over 1 m³

Requirements

Private households that are connected to the municipal waste disposal system.

Procedure

- Please deliver the garden waste in such a way that it can be safely loaded into the container by one person via a staircase (e.g. in bags, baskets or cardboard boxes).
- Transport containers that are wider than the container steps or can only be transported by two people will be rejected for safety reasons.

More information

This is garden waste:

- Leaves, grass, shrub and tree cuttings up to 10 cm in diameter and a maximum length of 2 m

This is not garden waste:

- Kitchen waste, tree trunks or stumps (see note above), construction timber (for example fences, palisades, sandboxes), animal litter, turf, stones, soil

Notes on delivery:

- Please deliver the garden waste in such a way that the waste can be safely loaded into the container by one person via a staircase (e.g. in bags, baskets or cardboard boxes).
- Transport containers that are wider than the container steps or can only be transported by two people will be rejected for safety reasons. Garden waste transported on open tarpaulins will also not be accepted.

Tip:

Compost garden waste in your own garden. This way you produce your own compost and avoid transportation to the recycling stations.

How long does it take to process

During peak periods, there may be selective waiting times or when replacement of green waste containers is necessary.

What are the costs?

No fees are charged for deliveries of up to 1 m³. Quantities above this are only accepted at the Blockland station for a fee.
