

Aggressive begging

Basic information

The public order service intervenes in the event of aggressive begging, it issues expulsions, warns or reports an administrative offence.

Requirements

Aggressive begging is defined as anyone who pushes, holds or touches people. Begging by and with children is prohibited.

Unobtrusive begging is not to be punished.

Procedure

The employees of the public order service instruct, issue warnings free of charge or for a fee, report administrative offences and take measures for general prevention of danger.

The public order service can levy a cash fine directly on site or report an administrative offence. In this case you will receive mail from the fine office.
